- The scholarship will provide full tuition, required fees and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and equipment for four years of full-time undergraduate study leading to a baccalaureate degree at any Indiana public or private college or university accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools
- The program is open to all members of the class of 2015 who are Jay County residents and have graduated from a regionally accredited Indiana high school
- The scholarship applicant must have been accepted to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study in the fall of 2015.
- The scholarship applicant must have a minimum 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale at the time of application
- The scholarship applicants are scored in the areas of Academics, Financial Need, Activities, and Written Essay.
- The scholarship applicant must complete and submit the application on or before January 6, 2015 to The Portland Foundation at icook@portlandfoundation.org
- The Portland Foundation will submit nominees to Independent Colleges of Indiana (ICI) in Spring 2015, who will make the final selection of the scholarship recipient(s)
