Message from The Portland Foundation

Dear Friends,

Thanks to your generosity, 2021 was a remarkable year for The Portland Foundation. The Foundation received \$1.16 million in new gifts and awarded \$1.07 million in grants and scholarships. Assets grew to an all-time high of \$50.76 million, surpassing the \$50 million mark for the first time.

The Portland Foundation's mission remains the same – to enhance the quality of life for the people of Jay County, now and for generations to come, by building community endowment, effecting significant impact through grantmaking and providing leadership on key community issues.


Providing leadership on key community issues has been the Foundation's focus in recent years. In 2021 the Foundation continued its work on Lilly Endowment Inc.'s seventh phase of the Giving Indiana Funds for Tomorrow (GIFT) Initiative. Lilly Endowment Inc. gave the Foundation the opportunity to enhance its community leadership skills through planning and implementation grants. In the implementation phase the Foundation is working on developing a strategy to combat the interrelated issues of the illicit drug epidemic, high child poverty, low post-secondary educational attainment, and low workforce development skills. Many community members have been assisting the Foundation on the work, which will be completed in 2022.

Local Impact Investing is another tool to assist the Foundation's leadership in the community. In 2021 the Foundation completed participation in a 12-month learning lab and has created a Local Impact Investing strategy. Local Impact Investing will allow the Foundation to invest in local for-profit and not-for-profit projects in the community.



Funds of The Portland Foundation

The Foundation is made up of many endowments, or “funds.” Each was established with a separate, simple agreement. Although pooled for investment purposes to benefit from economies of scale, each fund is accounted for separately.

You can establish your own fund or add to an existing endowment of The Portland Foundation. Gifts of any size can be added at any time. The Foundation currently administers 411 funds.

UNRESTRICTED FUNDS

Unrestricted funds enable the Foundation to respond to changes and opportunities in the community in a proactive manner. Donors who create and support these funds understand that unforeseen events and situations are inevitable, and the Foundation needs flexibility in addressing them. The donor allows the Board of Trustees the freedom to choose the grant recipients.

Established in 1975 by Mrs. Marian F. Abromson in memory of her father, James Fleming, a local attorney and civic leader.

Established in 1989 by Suzanne A. Joiner as a living memorial to her parents. Mr. and Mrs.

Abromson were local business and civic leaders and both served as Foundation trustees.

Established in 1996 by Richard W. Ashton as a memorial to his parents. Mr. Ashton worked as a salesman and Mrs. Ashton was a homemaker.

Russell H. Ashton, Ruth L. Ashton, and Richard W. Ashton Memorial Trust Fund First Financial Bank \$15,072

Established in 2006 by the will of Richard W. Ashton as a memorial to his parents and himself.

Kelly and Margaret Baggs Endowment \$1,189,272

Established in 2010 by Margaret Baggs. Mr. and Mrs. Baggs were responsible for the creation of the nature trails at Weiler-Wilson Park in Portland.

Charles A. Baird Trust \$26,129

Established in 1955 by Mr. Baird. He was the owner of the Baird Funeral Home and was one of the Foundation’s first trustees.

Clifford and Nancy Ball Endowment Fund \$134,632

Established in 2016 by the will of Nancy Ball. This unrestricted endowment will provide support to Jay County organizations under the

direction of the Foundation's Board of Trustees.

Charles and Helen Barrenbrugge Memorial

General Charitable Trust \$134,899

Established in 2008 by the Helen Barrenbrugge Estate. The fund shall be used for general public purposes of Jay County and the surrounding community.

Established in 2000 by Maxwell Naas through the Naas Family Charitable Endowment. Mr. Bynum was a longtime executive at Naas Foods, Inc. in Portland.

Lawrence H. and Mary Jane Calhoun Memorial Fund \$198,780

Established in 2007 by the Mary Jane Calhoun Estate. Mr. Calhoun was a local pharmacist for many years. He first became associated with Syphers Brothers Drug Store in 1929 and became a partner in 1950. The store later became known as Calhoun Drugs when Lawrence and his wife, Mary Jane, took over complete ownership. The store closed in 1971.

Community Enhancement Endowment Fund \$480,713

Established in 2001 by the Foundation Board with gifts received towards the Endowment's \$2 million challenge match under Lilly Endowment's GIFT V Initiative.

Robert and Kathleen Cue Endowment Fund \$41,818

Established in 2015 by the will of Kathleen J. Cue. Mrs. Cue had worked at the Haynes Milling Company, Mutual Security, and the Jay County Genealogy office. This unrestricted endowment will provide support to Jay County organizations under the direction of the Foundation's Board of Trustees.

James L. & Claudia A. Cull and Bill J. & Mary C. Davis Family Endowment Fund \$181,221

Established in 2014 by James & Claudia Cull and Bill & Mary Davis. This unrestricted endowment will provide support to Jay County organizations under the direction of the Foundation's Board of Trustees. Jim is a 1964 graduate of Portland High School. A

How to Give Through The Portland Foundation

Donors can give to existing funds or create new ones that best serve their needs and charitable interests. Prospective donors are urged to discuss the various options listed below with their attorney, accountant, or other financial advisor.

Endowment Funds

An endowment fund is a living memorial that may carry your family name. It creates a pool of charitable assets that provides enduring charitable support. Donors may choose one of five ways to have their contributions administered:

Unrestricted

The donor allows the Board of Trustees the freedom to choose the grant recipients and respond to changing needs in the community.

Field of Interest

The donor may specify a field of interest, but leaves selection of the exact recipients to the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

Restricted

The donor may name one or more particular agencies or institutions to receive grants.

Scholarship

The donor outlines the criteria for awards to deserving students so they may pursue educational opportunities.

Donor Advised

The donor may suggest possible grant recipients to the Foundation each year.

Planned Gifts Providing Lifetime Income

Planned gifts provide the benefits of charitable giving, while affording you and loved ones income from the donated assets.

Through The Portland Foundation, donors have the opportunity to preserve and strengthen the Jay County community. For information on these and other ways to use The Portland Foundation, call Doug Inman at (260) 726-4260.

Applying for Grants

The Portland Foundation encourages requests from any new or existing charitable organization or community agency in Jay County.

Grant Policies

Grant proposals must have direct relevance to Jay County charitable needs.

Areas The Portland Foundation wants to support are:

- Start-up costs for new programs
- One-time projects or needs
- Capital needs beyond an applicant organization's capabilities and means

Generally, The Portland Foundation does not support:

- Individuals, other than scholarships
- Religious or sectarian purposes
- Make-up of operating deficits, post-event or after-the-fact situations
- Endowment campaigns
- Propaganda, political or otherwise, attempting to influence legislation or intervene in any political affairs or campaigns

Requests are reviewed and voted on twice a year. Deadline dates are typically in January and July and are announced in the local media.

Foundation staff will review the grant request and will contact the requesting organization for any additional information or clarification. Following staff review, the proposals are sent to the Board of Trustees for evaluation and funding recommendation.

Following the next regularly scheduled board meeting, applicants are informed in writing of the Board's decisions as well as any conditions placed on a grant.

The mission of The Portland Foundation is to enhance the quality of life for the people of Jay County, Indiana, now and for generations to come, by building community endowment, effecting significant impact through grantmaking and providing leadership on key community issues.
